2. Lesson Learned

The program went very smoothly according to the agenda set, the residence seems energized and motivated after the movie because they think that such kind of programs refreshes them and encourages them to prepare mentally for their future. We felt the need of maintaining a good relationship is very important with them in order to let them feel comfortable while interacting.

The movie basically taught them that if there is a will there is a way forward, after completing the programs we really felt there need to be constant program to keep them engaged, many

suggested the program according to their interest like counselling, awareness , and entertainment program,

The office strongly feels that there should be a counselling programs in YDRC, because through interactions many of them suggested that it would be good if office can bring counselling programs at YDRC. Many who are serving the term at YDRC lack the counselling program to share their feelings and to motivate while in center.

3. Risk Analysis (Report on changes, challenges or achievements)

The only challenges we faced during the program was collection of release report of children and youth who are getting released on 2018, because they were quite reluctant to share on questions asked. Screening of motivational went very well, they were motivated, many shared about the needs of such kind of program to refresh themselves and keep them motivated while serving a term. Many said that this kind of program encourages them and makes them feel better in life.

4. Way forward

The one day program proved to be very successful. The program gave us an insight of what programs need to be implemented from the feedbacks given by the residence. Many doesn't have a solace support after their release which we need to keep in constant touch and do a follow up for those who are getting release this year. The collection of release report has given us the ideas to implement for their reintegration. We also briefed them about the upcoming programs that will be conducted in YDRC in future, through the support from Save the children.
